

North Tonawanda American Babe Ruth 2013 Playoff Rules

All regular season rules (national Babe Ruth Rules and local NTABR Rules) shall be in effect except for the following differences or clarifications:

1. Game Limits:

- 1.1. Victory margin - Games will end if the margin listed in the following table is equaled or exceeded after the minimum number of at bats by the losing team. This is the same as the regular season. This rule takes precedence over Rule 1.3 below.

Division	Margin	Minimum at bats
Minor	15	4
Major	10	4
Senior	10	5

- 1.2. Cal Ripken Minor division: Time limit is NOT in effect.

- 1.3. All divisions: Babe Ruth Rule 11.05-7 shall be in effect. Minor and Major games will be six (6) innings unless the home team leads after 5 ½ innings. Senior games will be 7 innings unless the home team leads after 6 ½ innings. Called games (except those called under the provisions of 1.1 above) will be completed from the point of discontinuance.

2. Pitching Limitations:

- 2.1. Minors: No pitcher, regardless of age, may pitch more than two (2) innings per game. There is no weekly limitation.

- 2.2. Majors and Seniors – Babe Ruth Rule 11.05-4 shall be in effect.

- 2.3. In Majors NO pitcher shall be allowed to pitch more than six (6) innings in any two (2) consecutive games.

- 2.4. In Seniors NO pitcher shall be allowed to pitch more than seven (7) innings in any two (2) consecutive games.
